OLD BUSINESS

Approval of minutes from January, 2011 meeting approved with 1st motion by Frank Ashley and 2nd by David Meadows

TREASURER REPORT

\$115 donation made to Trent Key Scholarship which will be forwarded to the counseling office for the existing scholarship set up by the counseling department.

Band Boosters agreed to donate \$225 to the Sturdivant family donation account to equal a \$500 donation.

Instrumentation fund has received 4694.50 from student transfers, \$600 (including donations for the Sturdivant Family, not instrumentation fund) from parents at last concert, \$9763.50 from parents and alumni.

NEW BUSINESS

Donation updates: refer to treasurer report. \$100 was donated from a benefit concert on 2/26/11 that was not school related. Mrs. Opiela Miksch visited with a couple who planned a concert at the Unitarian church who decided to make the donation. PTO donated \$1500 to drum line for the purchase of stands.

Web Site Changes: Mr. Henry's son (who is just awesome) is volunteering his time in updating the band website. PayPal account was set up about a month ago.

Spirit Store: the purchase format will be changing for easier navigation

Drum line update: Drums have been ordered from Pearl with delivery date around April
