

MacClaskey Scholarship

The MacClaskey Scholarship is an award presented to one, or two outstanding graduating band seniors each year. The award is based on leadership, musicianship and scholarship. To be eligible, a student must have fulfilled the following requirements:

1. Participation in marching and concert band for the student's full high school career.
2. Must have held a leadership position in the band program
3. Must have a 3.0, or above academic average.
4. Must have participated in region band auditions
5. Must have participated in solo and ensemble contests
6. Must be a graduating senior
7. Must be in good standing in the band program

If you have met the above requirements, you are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Awards will range from a minimum of \$250 to a maximum of \$500. The maximum amount may be exceeded, if donations warrant such an increase.

- To apply, fill out the form below and return it to the band hall office in a sealed envelope no later than March 31 at 4:00pm. No late applications will be accepted.
- Address the envelope: MacClaskey Scholarship Application.

** Additionally provide at least two letters of reference from either a non-music faculty member, or a community member.
